Human Development

The concept of human development has its origin in the writings of early economists like Adam Smith, Robert Malthus, John Straut Mill and others. The concept of human development was first laid out by Amartya Sen, a 1998 Nobel laureate and expanded by Martha Nussbaum, Sabina Alkire, and Ingrid Robeyns. According to Amartya Sen, the core of human well-being is freedom of choice by enhancing people's capabilities for attaining higher standards of knowledge, health, self- respect and ability to participate in the community life. The goal of development is the "promotion and expansion of valuable capabilities".

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The three essential ones that can indicate human development are:

- To acquire knowledge,
- To lead a long and healthy life,
- To enable the resources needed for a decent standard of living.

There are six basic indicators of human development which are equality, sustainability, productivity, empowerment, cooperation and security.

- Equality related capabilities or access to opportunities what is essential is that the societal institutional structure needs to be more favourable and progressive.
- Sustainability focuses on the desired balance between future economic growth and environmental quality. Sustainable development focuses on the need to maintain the long term protective capacity of the biosphere.
- Productivity is requires investment in people, this is commonly called investment in human capital. Investment in human capital, in addition to physical capital can add more productivity.
- Empowerment implies a political democracy in which people themselves make the decisions about their lives. Under it, people enjoy greater political and civil liberties and remain free from excessive controls and regulations.
- Cooperation stipulates participation and belonging to the communities and groups as a means of mutual enrichment and a source of social meaning.
- Security offers people development opportunities freely and safely with confidence that they will
 not disappear suddenly in the future.

Education and Human Development

Education is a necessary tool in human development and also the process through which human personality develops. The aim of education is better knowledge, understanding, better earnings, better living conditions and higher status in society. Education can include activities such as learning new skills, creating a personal development, developing talents, creating human capital, developing spiritually and improving self-knowledge. According to John Dewey, education is the development of all those capacities in the individual which enable him to control his environment and fulfill his possibilities. Education affects social, economic and political development of human life.

Social development is a broad concept encompassing improvement in the social status of the people. According to L.T. Hobhouse the social development of men in their mutual relations, the relation of men may spring from the natures of those engaged in them and may return upon then heightening and fulfilling their natural capacities. This what we have called harmony in social relationship or again they may involve a greater or less degree of constraint exercised by some of the parties upon others. With this consideration before us we may conclude that a community develop as it advance in efficiency, freedom and mutuality.

- By freedom is meant scope for thought, character and initiate on the part of member of the community.
- By mutuality service of an end in which each who serve participate.





- Educational attainment as measured by a combination of adult literacy and combined primary, secondary and tertiary enrolment ratio.
- Longevity as measured by life expectancy at birth.
- Decent standard of living as measured by real GDP per capita based on purchasing power parity in terms of dollar.
