Impact of Women Empowerment towards Social Issues

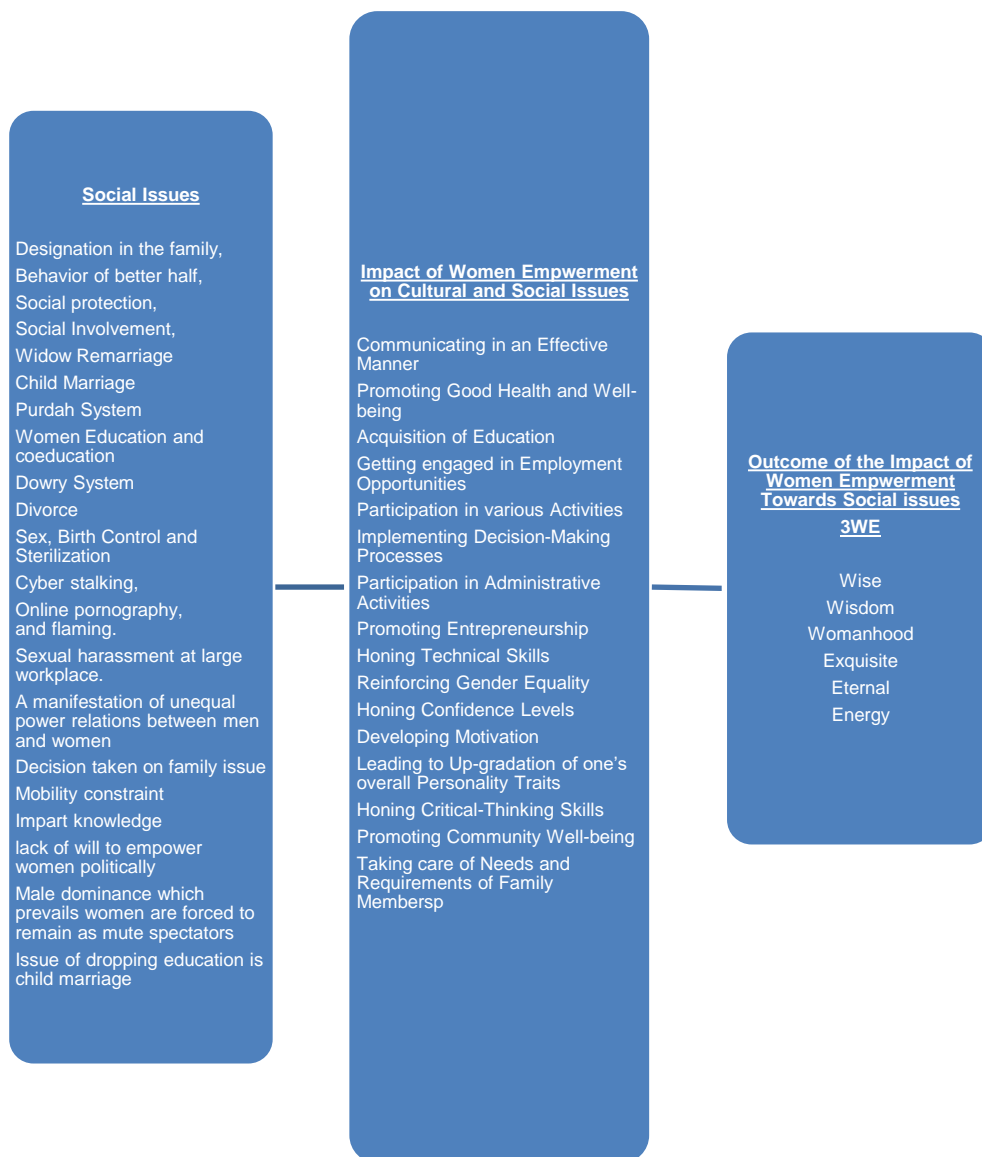
